Note: The Electronic certificates are rendered valid as the original documents in their digital form. When printed a copy of this email must be stored with the certificate copies to confirm the validity of the certificates.

Actions for approval holder to take post issuance of UK CAA Approval

1. This certificate attached now provides you full UK approval privileges IAW the certificate scope of approval and should now be used for all work on UK G Reg aircraft and/or components for fitment to UK aircraft. You should NOT use practice 3 or your EU/EASA approval after the date of issue of the UK approval to complete previously mentioned work.
2. **Within 1 month of issuance of UK Approval:** provide the CAA a updated and signed UK Exposition supplement. Attached is a UK supplement template to your EU/EASA Exposition; this details the differences between the UK and EU systems to allow you to be compliant within the UK system and therefore enable you to operate your UK approval effectively. This supplement does need some updating to reflect your organisation and should be placed alongside your existing EU/EASA Exposition as both parts now constitute the scope of your UK approval. Once updated and signed by the Accountable Manager a copy should be submitted to apply@caa.co.uk

Note: Failure to complete this step will invalidate your approval and therefore the UK CAA will raise findings to limit or suspend the approval.

3. If your approval requires the issuance of CAA form 1 certificates for engine or component release then a template of the CAA Form 1 can be found on our website: [Forms | Civil Aviation Authority \(caa.co.uk\)](https://www.caa.co.uk/Forms/CivilAviationAuthority). There are two versions of the Template one for Production/Manufacturing (21G) and one for Maintenance (MF/CAO/145) please ensure you use the correct version for your organisation type.
4. **Before 31st December 2022** provide the CAA a UK specific Exposition which once approved will replace the use of your EU/EASA Exposition with associated UK supplement. This exposition should include all UK centric Form templates with your details included e.g. CAA Form 1. Submissions will be to apply@caa.co.uk

5. **Before 31st December 2022** provide the CAA with CAA Form 4's for all postholders. Link to Form 4 is here: [SRG1705: CAA Form 4 - Details of Nominated Personnel - Airworthiness Organisations](https://www.caa.co.uk/SRG1705)
6. Please ensure in the interim period while the UK exposition is being drafted and approved that any amendment to your EU/EASA exposition, Certifying Staff Listing, Capability Listing or procedures referenced in the Exposition are sent to the CAA, submissions will be to apply@caa.co.uk. These amendments will not be directly approved by the CAA but we require the amendments for our records.
7. Any change which requires an approval certificate change (e.g. rating change) will require an application via CAA approval specific application pages: [Organisation and maintenance programme approvals | Civil Aviation Authority \(caa.co.uk\)](https://www.caa.co.uk/organisation-and-maintenance-programme-approvals) Note: Any scope of approval change to the EU/EASA approval will NOT effect the UK approval until such times an application is made and the new UK certificate is issued.
